# Attendance Improvements

I am thrilled to share some exciting news about our efforts to address chronic absenteeism at our school. Last year, approximately 15% of our students were considered chronically absent, which means they missed more than eighteen days of school. However, I am delighted to report that this year, we have made significant progress! Our dedicated team has worked tirelessly to reduce chronic absenteeism, along side our parents, and we've achieved remarkable results. The current rate of chronically absent students is now almost 10%—a substantial improvement!

The Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) released the annual Virginia Standards of Learning (SOL) test results and updated the <u>School Quality Profile</u>. We are well on our way to fully recovering from the pandemic. Occoquan has scored some of the highest scores in Reading and Math. Our African-American scores are what I am most proud of, as we have now surpassed the achievement gap in this category. PWCS will work diligently to support continued academic progress, acceleration, and recovery.


