Updated Attendance Information

The regulation 724-1 (Student Attendance Absences, Excuses, and Tardies) has been updated recently, and there are some MAJOR changes that everyone should read.

- After five unexcused absences, parents will be required to have a conference with admin to discuss attendance
- After ten unexcused absences, there will be a legal referral made by the attendance officer
- If a child is absent for three straight days or ten total days, a doctor's note will be required
- **FAMILY TRIPS ARE NOW CONSIDERED UNEXCUSED**
- For any emergency situation, the students will only be considered excused for two days. Any additional absent days will result in day three and beyond to be considered unexcused.

New Cell Phone Policy

The information below is what the school board has passed and will be reinforced at all elementary schools starting this school year:

Elementary and Combination (K-8 and Traditional) School Grade Students

- All cell phones and personal electronic communication devices must be turned off and stored away and may not be used at any time within the school building or on school grounds or during any instructional periods, regardless of location, including field trips.
- Dual-purpose watches may be worn at school, but wireless/cellular features must be turned off during the school day (e.g., must be placed in airplane mode).
- Students are permitted to use their cell phones and personal electronic communication devices(s) while on school buses, while in parent/guardian vehicles, and before they enter or after they exit school grounds.
- Cell phones and wireless communication devices may be used on school buses provided the device does not distract the driver, compromise safety, or violate the Prohibited Content and Use for All Students provisions detailed below.

Kiss and Ride Application

As we begin this school year, I want to share an important update regarding transportation and campus logistics. Due to ongoing construction and limited space, our school will face significant challenges—especially with the volume of car riders.

To help alleviate congestion and ensure a safe and efficient arrival and dismissal process, we strongly encourage families to utilize school bus transportation whenever possible. Riding the bus will greatly reduce traffic and help keep our routines running smoothly.

However, if you choose to drop off or pick up your child by car, please be aware of the following:

- You must complete the Car Rider Application to receive a car rider number.
- This number must be displayed during pickup. Without it, you will be required to park and go to the office to sign your child out.
- The car rider line will only serve families with an official car rider number.

We appreciate your cooperation and patience as we navigate these challenges together. Your support is essential in keeping our students safe and our school day running efficiently.

New Student for School Year 2025-26?

Student immunizations due by August 15, 2025, to begin new school year

The deadline to meet the immunization requirements for the upcoming school year is **August 15, 2025**. If proof of required immunizations is not provided by the deadline, the student will not be permitted to start school on **Monday, August 18, 2025**, until documentation is provided.

Parents/guardians can view information about student immunization compliance in [ParentVUE](#).

For specific questions about immunization non-compliance or for assistance in setting up a ParentVUE account, please contact your school. A list of immunization requirements can be found below.

Once completed, provide documentation to your student's school indicating that your student has received the immunization(s). All documentation must include the **student's full name and ID number**. Immunization information must be delivered in person to the school's office.

If your student cannot receive an immunization for some reason, the health provider must give you a medical exemption statement to provide to your student's school.

Our African-American scores are what I am most proud of, as we have now surpassed the achievement gap in this category. PWCS will work diligently to support continued academic progress, acceleration, and recovery.

Students are no longer allowed to be dismissed from the office between the times of 3:30 and 4:00 due to disruptions to the dismissal process. Construction on the New Building

Construction on Occoquan's new building began recently when they started digging two of the one-hundred-ten holes they will need to dig for our geothermal energy. It has been an exciting time. The students are predicted to move into the building in December 2025. The new building will be located on the grass behind the playground. Construction will officially begin in June 2024, but they will continue to work on some of the other aspects that take a little longer well before that time frame.

Summary:

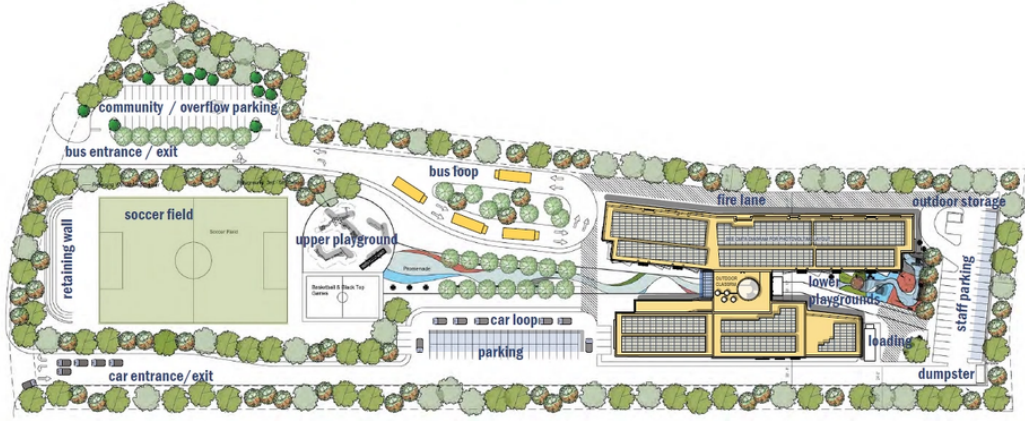
The Building is situated at the far East of the site with the front entrance lobby leading to the heart of the school. In the heart, there is a circular monumental stair with an integrated indoor slide that connects the first two levels. With the Gymnasium and Cafeteria on the first floor and the Media Center on the second floor, all of these spaces are connected to the heart of the school. An academic wing to the north houses most all of the classrooms, except for music and strings which is located across from the media center. The Academic wing is 3 stories tall, while the other portions of the building are 2 stories tall.

There is a secured playground in the East courtyard for Kindergartners. There are spaces for other playgrounds around the site, including in the front close to the academic side of the building. There will be landscape and playgrounds and athletics fields accessed by the public close to Occoquan Road.

The traffic flow and drop off is controlled by separating the bus loop (on the North) and car loop (on the south) of the campus. There is a walkway in the center of the site to provide the opportunity to connect the front playgrounds and fields to the school in a playful manner.

PARENTAL RIGHT TO INFORMATION ABOUT TEACHERS:

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act, most recently reauthorized as the Every Student Succeeds Act, states that parents in Title I schools have the right to request certain information about their child’s teachers. The information that you have a right to request about your child’s teacher is:

- Whether the teacher has met state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subjects the teacher is teaching.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing has been waived.
- The baccalaureate degree major of certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

At Occoquan ES, we are extremely proud of our teachers and paraprofessionals, and are happy to provide you with any of the information above pertaining to your child’s teacher(s). If you have such a request, please call the school at 703.494.2195 and ask for the information you are interested in.

Parental Opt Out of Assessments

Parental Notification of Assessment Opt Out Policies under The Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 According to the Virginia Department of Education, "All students in tested grade levels and courses are expected to participate in Virginia's assessment program, unless specifically exempted by state or federal law or by Board of Education regulations." On December 10, 2015, the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA) was signed into law. Section 1112(e)(2) of ESSA states that parents of students in Title I schools have a right to know about state or division policies regarding student participation in any assessments mandated by ESSA, including any policy, procedure, or parental right to opt students out of such assessments. The Commonwealth of Virginia does not currently have an Opt Out policy for SOL assessments. However, Section 22.1-253.13:3.Cof the Code of Virginia states that, "The Board of Education shall not include in its calculation of the passage rate of a Standards of Learning assessment for the purposes of state accountability any student whose parent has decided to not have his child take such Standards of Learning assessment, unless such exclusions would result in the school's not meeting any required state or federal participation rate." Prince William County Public Schools regulations state that, if a parent or guardian decides to not have a student take a state or local assessment, then the person making the request should be informed about the academic consequences that decision could have on the student.
