Student Device Insurance

Bell Schedule Change

As we begin our preparation for the 2023-24 school year, I want to remind you that the bell schedule for our school will change to improve on-time school bus service. Effective on the first day of school, the bell schedule for Occoquan ES for the 2023-24 school year follows: 9:20 AM to 4:00 PM

The updated bell schedule provides the following benefits:

- Makes transportation to and from school more consistent and reliable.
- Increases the number of buses for schools and drivers available for substitute runs.
- Decreases route times and length of time waiting at bus stops.
- Eliminates scheduled double and triple runs.
- Improves student attendance.
- Reduces the chance of lost instructional time.
- Decreases the need for staff to stay after school dismissal for supervision.
- Reduces the number of students on each bus, resulting in fewer management challenges for drivers.
- Improves accuracy of the Here Comes the Bus app.

PARENTAL RIGHT TO INFORMATION ABOUT TEACHERS

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act, most recently reauthorized as the Every StudentSucceeds Act, states that parents in Title I schools have the right to request certain information about their child's teachers. Parental Notification of Assessment Opt Out Policies under The Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015

According to the Virginia Department of Education, "All students in tested grade levels and courses are expected to participate in Virginia's assessment program, unless specifically exempted by state or federal law or by Board of Education regulations." On December 10, 2015, the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA) was signed into law. Section 1112(e)(2) of ESSA states that parents of students in Title I schools have a right to know about state or division policies regarding student participation in or any assessments mandated by ESSA, including any policy, procedure, or parental right to opt students out of such assessments. The Commonwealth of Virginia does not currently have an Opt-Out policy for SOL assessments. However, Section 22.1-253.13:3.C of the Code of Virginia states that, "The Board of Education shall not include in its calculation of the passage rate of a Standards of Learning assessment for the purposes of state accountability any student whose parent has decided to not have his child take such Standards of Learning assessment, unless such exclusions would result in the school's not meeting any required state or federal participation rate." Prince William County Public Schools regulations state that, if a parent or guardian decides to not have a student take a state or local assessment, then the person making the request should be informed about the academic consequences that decision could have on the student.
